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





We are already waiting for the next year to come, to see our families again. Happy Thanksgiving everyone, let's celebrate!

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





Activity 15 Comparatives and Superlatives

Adjectives can help compare two or more things. Add –er when forming the comparative to compare two things. Add –est when forming the superlative to compare more than two things. Some adjectives change their spelling in the comparative and superlative forms.

Spelling Rule

Comparative

Superlative

If an adjective ends with a consonant and y, change the y to i and add –er or – est.	happy - happier	happy - happiest
If an adjective ends with e, drop the e and add –er or –est.	wise - wiser	wise - wisest
If an adjective has one syllable and ends with a vowel followed by a consonant, double the final consonant and add –er or –est.	dim - dimmer	dim - dimmest


