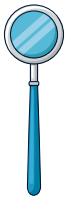

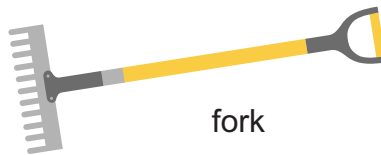

In theatre:

- Learn the stage directions in the script.
- Where and how to move.
- Stage combat.
- Learn choreographies.

In film:

- Acting training.
- Get used and feel comfy with the camera.
- Stay in position.
- Perform on screen tests.
- Performance of emotions.

In television:

- Use screen acting.
- Use microphones.
- To know the frame of the camera.

Thailand:

In Thailand, people only use the spoon to take the food into their mouths when eating, doing this with a fork is considered a bad habit.



India:

People in India traditionally eat with their hands. They only use their fingers, not the entire hand. They wash their hands very well before eating.



England:

In England, people don't start eating until everyone on the table has been served. When you are visiting someone you have to wait until the host indicates that you can begin.



China:

People in China use chopsticks to eat. It is offensive to use the chopsticks to point at people or to use them as drum sticks on the table when eating.



Italy:

People in Italy don't serve all the food in one plate. When they eat, they use separate plates for each type of food. The spaghetti on one plate, the meat on another plate, and the salad on a different plate.



Iran:

In Iran, people commonly eat their meals sitting on the floor, and they only use the right hand to touch the food.
